<b>BALBLAIR 12YR</b>	£7.50
Matured in American oak ex bourbon and double fired American oak casks, bringing elegant complexity and warmth.	
<b>CLYNELISH 14YR</b>	£8.00
Quite light with a little orange and smoke on the nose with mixed fruit and vanilla on the palate with a long finish.	
<b>DALMORE 12YR</b>	£8.00
Seville oranges, dried fruits, and hints of vanilla pods.	
<b>DALMORE CIGAR MALT</b>	£12.00
Smooth chocolate pudding and Christmas cake. Finish is long and sweet; molasses and chocolate.	
<b>DALMORE KING ALEXANDER III</b>	£32.00
Complex blend of almonds, hedgerow berries, plums, brittle toffee and a faint whiff of treacle. Equally complex on the palate, with sherry, fresh berries merging with plum notes, plus vanilla and toffee influences from the Bourbon barrels.	
<b>DALMORE PORT WOOD RESERVE</b>	£12.00
Nectarines, creamy caramel, roasted chestnuts, and Java coffee.	
<b>DALMORE 12YR SHERRY CASK</b>	£11.50
Dark chocolate and crushed almonds. with a dusting of cinnamon.

<b>DALWHINNIE 15YR</b>	£8.00
Remarkably smooth; long-lasting flavour development. Aromatic, heather honey notes give way to cut grass and malty sweetness that intensifies to a sudden burst of peat.	
<b>GLENDRONACH 12YR</b>	£7.00
Rich, creamy, silky-smooth. Warm, rich oak and sherry sweetness, full mouth feel, raisins and soft fruits.	
<b>GLEN GARIOCH 12YR</b>	£7.00
The colour of sharp honey, on the nose heathery floral notes are balanced with the richness of poached pears and the sweetness of malted barley.	
<b>GLENGOYNE 10YR</b>	£7.00
Clean. Green apples and grass, soft oak and a hint of sweet liquorice. Water brings linseed oil and almonds..	
<b>GLENMORANGIE 10YR</b>	£6.50
Toffee, nutty, with fresh oranges and lemons.	
<b>GLENMORANGIE LASANTA</b>	£7.50
Malty and spicy, with vanilla fudge, walnuts and raisins.	
<b>GLENMORANGIE QUINTA RUBAN 14YR</b>	£6.50
A whisky journey into the wild, The Quinta Ruban is like a dark and delectable forest, where the wind whistles with gusts of peppermint and dark swirls of chocolate can happen at any moment

**GLENMORANGIE ACCORD 12 YR** £8.00

Matured in a combination of American oak bourbon casks and hand-selected Oloroso sherry casks. The whiskies are married together, created a well-balanced expression filled with juicy red berry notes and waves of warming butterscotch.

**GLENMORANGIE THE CADBOLL ESTATE 15 YR** £6.00

Crafted by Glenmorangie from field to glass, this limited-edition series brings the spirit and flavour of our Highland home to whisky lovers around the globe. Aged for 15 years, the third batch of Glenmorangie The Cadboll Estate brings a nutty and spicy twist to the series' award-winning flavour.

**GLENMORANGIE THE TRIBUTE 16 YR** £12.00

Offers an aroma of floral, spring meadows and freshly mowed grass, gentle wafts of peat and charred oak, fruity citrus and crème caramel.

**GLENMORANGIE 18 YR** £12.00

Like the golden edge of an autumn afternoon, The 18 Years Old is a dazzling, luminous whisky, balancing sweet and floral lushness, with rich marmalade flavours, honey and fig.

**GLENMORANGIE AMONTILLADO** £12.00

A soft and mouthcoating texture is wonderfully balanced by effervescent and spicy notes. Clove and ginger find harmony with Glenmorangie's signature citrus tastes of orange sherbet, lemon balsam and eucalyptus oil, with undertones of walnut oil and leather.

### **GLENMORANGIE COGNAC** £6.50

Sweet and almost sparkling, like toffee apples and baked pears scattered with almonds and slices of mandarin orange. That fruitiness is deliciously threaded with clove, star anise and soft hints of leather.

### **GLENMORANGIE MALAGA** £12.00

A rich, oily texture brings sultanas, raisins and dates bursting onto the palate. Mandarin orange, milk chocolate, honey and more brown sugar come to the fore, beautifully woven with vibrant citrus. Then cinnamon, ginger, nutmeg and star anise emerge, before hazelnut, honey and gentle oak shine through in a long, mellow finish.

### **GLENMORANGIE THE NECTAR D'OR** £6.00

Sipping The Nectar d'Or is like sending your senses on holiday to a French pastry shop, where the air swirls with sweet scents, balanced by a soft drumbeat of spice.

### **GLENMORANGIE PALO CORTADO** £12.00

An oily yet peppery texture leads to a burst of rich, sweet flavours. Treacle toffee and milk chocolate are threaded with notes of clove, ginger, cinnamon and nutmeg. Meanwhile, fruity undertones of raisins, dark plums and bitter orange find delectable balance with baking ryebread and salted nuts.

### **GLENMORANGIE TALE OF THE FORREST** £12.50

Flavour explodes in the mouth. Whirls of peppermint. Bursts of eucalyptus. Rustles of bitter orange. All floating on clouds of vanilla with intriguing hints of black liquorice.

<b>GLENMORANGIE TARLOGAN</b>	£12.00
A splash of water releases a combination of creamy vanilla and some floral notes, such as narcissus or verbena, but the most defining note is the constant creamy vanilla and coconut. A soft, silky texture leads into a symphony of a sweet dessert like notes, such as vanilla custard, pears, banoffee pie, pineapple and a gentle citrus note.	
<b>GLENWYVIS</b>	£6.50
Vanilla fudge, sherbet fizz and pear drops.	
<b>OBAN 14YR</b>	£11.00
Delicate at first. Perfumy. Faint hints of fruity seaweed, then lightly waxy becoming smoky.	
<b>OLD PULTENEY 12YR</b>	£6.00
Light, honey and nuts. Fresh, oily and salty.	
<b>ROYAL LOCHNAGAR 12YR</b>	£6.50
Dry; medium-length, with an attractive lingering sandalwood aftertaste.	
<b>SEVEN SONS 9 YR</b>	£7.50
Spicy, dried fruits, resinous, blood orange, tobacco & honey.

### TEANNINICH 10 YR

£6.00

Medium-body with a pleasant dryness. There are notes of barley sugars and cereal notes. There are some oily herbal notes with more of that citric acidity developing with a hint of espresso.

### TOMATIN 12YR

£6.00

Sweet flavours of ripe apples, pears and a subtle suggestion of nuts. Long, lingering, pleasantly oily aftertaste.

<b>ABERLOUR 12YR</b>	£6.50
Distinctively clinging mouthfeel, with long-lasting flavour development. Both sweetness and spicy, peppery dryness in its malt character. Nutmeg and berry fruit.	
<b>BALVENIE CARIBBEAN CASK 14YR</b>	£8.00
Matured in Caribbean rum casks which bring a vanilla note with spicy aromatic undertones.	
<b>BALVENIE DOUBLEWOOD 12YR</b>	£7.00
Beautifully combined mellow flavours: nutty, sweet, sherried. A very orangey fruitiness. Heather. Cinnamon spiciness.	
<b>BENROMACH 10YR</b>	£5.50
Intense and complex yet beautifully balanced with a touch of smoke. Delicious forest fruits and creamy malt. Luscious sherry notes.	
<b>BENROMACH 15YR</b>	£8.50
Rich fruit cake with stewed plum, red apple skin and the sharp edge of kiwi fruit. With water, very satisfying with traces of charred oak complementing sweet tangerine, plum and nectarines and completed by a gorgeous touch of milk chocolate.	
<b>CARDHU 12YR</b>	£7.00
Light to medium, with the emphasis on malty sweetness and vanilla.

<b>CRAGGANMORE 12YR</b>	£6.00
Delicate, clean, restrained; a huge range of herbal, flowery notes.	
<b>GLENFARCLAS 10YR</b>	£6.00
Crisp and dry at first, with sherry sweetness and nuttiness developing.	
<b>GLENFIDDICH 12YR</b>	£6.50
Malty sweetness, white chocolate and toasted hazelnuts; good flavour development.	
<b>GLENROTHES SELECT RESERVE</b>	£5.50
Sherry, dried fruits, balanced with spice.	
<b>GLENLIVET CARRIBEAN RESERVE</b>	£6.50
Rich caramel toffee notes, followed by flavours of tropical fruits.	
<b>GLENLIVET FOUNDERS RESERVE</b>	£7.00
Zesty orange, pear, toffee apples.	
<b>LINKWOOD 12YR</b>	£8.50
Medium, oily. Honey, pine oil. Malt, almond.	



## Speyside

<b>THE MACALLAN 12YR</b>	£9.00
Fruity, both citrus and dried sweet, with ginger and cinnamon. Soft oak tones showing toasted apples.	
<b>MORTLACH 12YR</b>	£7.50
Fresh and fragrant nutty fruit cake with juicy sultanas, candied ginger and bitter sweet marmalade developing into dark chocolate, baked apples, nutmeg and hazelnuts.	
<b>SINGLETON OF DUFFTOWN 12YR</b>	£6.00
A straightforward, nutty and malty single malt from Speyside, the Singleton of Dufftown was released to replace the Singleton of Auchroisk. It's aged in a high proportion of European oak casks.	
<b>TAMDHU 12YR</b>	£8.00
Silky texture that coats the mouth with banana, berry jam, malt biscuit and classic sherry oak depth.	



## Islay

<b>ARDBEG 10YR</b>	£7.00
Burning peats and dried fruits, followed by malt and a touch of liquorice. Finish is long and smoky. Cereal sweetness, iodine and dry peat.	
<b>BOWMORE 12YR</b>	£6.00
Smoky and citric, with developing cocoa notes.	
<b>BRUICHLADDICH; THE CLASSIC LADDIE</b>	£6.50
Ripe green fruit, brown sugar and sweet malt. Floral, elegant and unpeated.	
<b>BUNNAHABHAIN 12</b>	£6.00
Light with fruit notes, nutty flavours with a sweetness and slight hints of vanilla and caramel.	
<b>LAGAVULIN 16YR</b>	£12.00
Rich malt and sherry with fruity sweetness, pronounced peat and smoke. As the palate develops, oily, grassy with salty notes emerging. Finish is warming and impactful.	
<b>LAPHROAIG 10YR</b>	£7.00
Crispy, peaty, seaweedy, salty and oily. Finish is round and very dry.	
<b>LAPHROAIG SELECT</b>	£8.50
Sweet at first, followed by peat smoke and dashes of ash and seaweed.	



## Lowland

<b>AUCHENTOSHAN AMERICAN OAK</b>	£7.00
Triple distilled and matured solely in American bourbon casks. The result: a Lowland Single Malt Whisky with the sweet aromas of vanilla and coconut - along with the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.	
<b>AUCHENTOSHAN THREE WOOD</b>	£7.00
Perfumed, lemongrass, cashews. Long and creamy finish, with raisins, aniseed and fresh oak.	
<b>GLENKINCHIE 12YR</b>	£7.00
Sweet and fruity apple compote with a good oakiness.	
<b>GLEN SCOTIA 15YR</b>	£8.00
Hints of vanilla oak, subtle notes of sea spray and spicy aromatic fruits.	



## Island

<b>THE ARRAN MALT 10YR</b>	£6.50
The 10-year-old carries aromas of honey and sweet oak. On the palate it is crisp with a hint of nut, with time the malt opens up its fruits on the tongue.	
<b>CAOL ILA 12YR</b>	£6.50
Intense and rich, with malted barley and gentle floral touches overcome by smoky notes.	
<b>HIGHLAND PARK 12YR</b>	£6.00
Smoky dryness, heather honey sweetness and maltiness.	
<b>ISLE OF JURA 10YR</b>	£7.00
Sweetish; slowly developing a slight island dryness and saltiness.	
<b>ISLE OF JURA JOURNEY</b>	£6.00
Melted butter, sugared almond, a very light hint of smoke on the nose. On the palate honeyed-drenched pear, toffee and pencil shavings. Finish is oily walnut and light apricot sweetness.	
<b>SCAPA THE ORCADIAN</b>	£7.50
Smooth and sweet, ripe honeydew melon slices, bursts of fruity pear and lemon sherbet. Long, refreshing, shimmering sweetness.	



## Island

<b>TALISKER 10YR</b>	£6.50
Smoky, malty sweet, with sourness and big pepperiness developing.	
<b>TALISKER SKYE</b>	£7.00
Rich notes of stewed apple and pear with some treacle toffee and hint of marzipan. There's some subdued smoke puffing away in the background.	
<b>TALISKER STORM</b>	£7.00
Rich and unexpectedly honeyed initially. Then some pleasing singed oaky notes and bandagey aromas.	
<b>TOBERMORY 12YR</b>	£6.50
Rounded malt notes once again, now a touch oily. Still packs a hearty helping of stone fruit sweetness.
